REGISTRATION CHEQUE

Registration cheques can be the current date or post-dated no later than February 15, 2012. Rates are payable from oldest to youngest. Registration is available right up to opening day, unless divisions are full. Registration is on a first-come first-service basis, so you may be placed on a waiting list. Proof of age will be required for any new player who has not played in our Association before. **Make cheque or money order payable to C.M.B.A. Late registrations received after February 15, 2012 will be assessed a \$20.00 late fee (T-Ball and Blastball registrations are due April 1st).**
REFUNDS: No refunds issued after the first game played. **NSF CHEQUES:** There is a \$15 fee for all NSF cheques.

UNIFORM DEPOSIT CHEQUE

A separate \$100.00 cheque per child (**except Blastball or T-Ball**) post dated for June 1, 2012 **must** be submitted at the time of registration. This cheque will be destroyed upon receipt of the uniform in clean and good condition at the end of the season. Regulation helmets are mandatory for all players in our Association. **Make cheque payable to C.M.B.A.**
