2024 Rangers Tryout Information

On behalf of Bob Foerster, General Manager of the Cloverdale Rangers program, we would like to share the upcoming tryout dates for the High-Performance teams:

13U AAA & AA (Pee Wee): Feb 24th & 25th

Feb 24th - start time 12:00pm at the Cloverdale Batting Cage Feb 25th - start time 11:00am at Cloverdale Athletic Park (all weather field)

15U AAA & AA (Bantam) Feb 10th & 11th

Feb 10th - start time 11:00am at Cloverdale Athletic Park (all weather field) Feb 11th - start time 12:00pm at the Cloverdale Batting Cage

18U Midget: Feb 20th, 22nd, & 24th

Feb 20th - 4-6pm at Tamanawis Field Feb 22nd - 7-830pm Cloverdale Batting Cage Feb 24th - 10am-1pm Cloverdale Athletic Park (all weather field) (if needed)

There will be a \$10 tryout fee to cover costs of facilities and coaches; CASH ONLY will be accepted. Please bring this fee on the first day of tryouts. Please arrive 15 minutes before start

Note: Players trying out for 13U AA, 13U AAA, 15U AA, 15U AAA MUST have a tryout release if you do not live within the BC Baseball defined catchment area for Cloverdale Minor Baseball, please follow the instructions below.

Association Boundaries (bcminorbaseball.org)


Refer to this rule for Tryout Releases for 13U AA, 13U AAA, 15U AA & 15U AAA **Rule 6.02 Permission to play in an association outside the boundaries of residence.**

Player tryout release must be submitted online (link you note below). Players do not have to notify home association of this as on the BCMBA online form it asks if "your home association offers the program yes/no"...then further down the online form it has this "If Home Association approval answer is yes, a separate email must accompany this application from the Home Association stating so. Sent to <u>eligibility@bcminorbaseball.org</u> Include players name and approval" so this pertains to players trying out elsewhere for program(s) they may also offer (13U AA, 13U AAA, 15U AA & 15U AAA).

18U AAA (also includes CP) does not apply to Rule 6; refer to Rule 7.07 for 18U AAA which same as CP just have to provide player home association 5 days notice in writing to 18U AAA Director and home association.

Side Note: BCMBA has 7-10 days to approve so request should be submitted as soon as possible by player. There usually are well over 100+ of these each year for them to go through.

Cost Breakdowns

General notes that applies to all 6 Rangers HP teams.

- Team fees are determined at the start of the year based on anticipated costs and budgeting for coaching stipends, season/tournament travel & tournament fees etc. Individual team performance and actual in season costs might be less than the amount budgeted.
- To be clear the Team Fees paid to the program for a specific team are <u>not</u> subject to end of year refund of any kind.
- Should expenses be less than those budgeted when fees are determined the excess money will be retained by the program to cover future costs and absorbed into the program.

<u>13U AA Team</u>

- CMBA Basic Cost for Registration \$270 before Feb 1, 2024, \$300 after Feb 1, 2024 (note this registration MUST be complete prior to attending Rangers Tryouts, see Tryout information later in this document)
- Selection to this team will be an additional \$325 payable to CMBA via a separate registration link that will be sent to those players after the tryouts. Payment due by March 31st.
- Rangers AA Team Fee of \$100 payable by E-Transfer to <u>rangers13ufinance@gmail.com</u> Payment due April 15, 2024.
- Rangers uniform cost, there are items that are mandatory and others that are optional, cost will be determined by any extra items purchased, see example of uniform costs in appendix A attached, along with working spreadsheet for your use.
- As this team is **not** a single season team there will be an additional \$200 for the Summer Ball Season payable by E-Transfer to <u>rangers13ufinance@gmail.com</u> This will be due June 1, 2024
 - Therefore, total cost (<u>not including Uniform</u>) is \$895.00 or \$925.00

13U AAA Team

- CMBA Basic Cost for Registration \$270 before Feb 1, 2024, \$300 after Feb 1, 2024 (note this registration MUST be complete prior to attending Rangers Tryouts, see Tryout information later in this document)
- Selection to this team will be an additional \$600 payable to CMBA via a separate registration link that will be sent to those players after the tryouts. Payment due by March 31st.
- Rangers AAA Team Fee of \$200 payable by E-Transfer to <u>rangers13ufinance@gmail.com</u> Payment due April 15, 2024.
- Rangers uniform cost, there are items that are mandatory and others that are optional, cost will be determined by any extra items purchased, see example of uniform costs in appendix A attached.
 - Therefore, total cost (<u>not including Uniform</u>) is \$1070.00 or \$1100.00



15U AA Team

- CMBA Basic Cost for Registration \$320 before Feb 1, 2024, \$360 after Feb 1, 2024 (note this registration MUST be complete prior to attending Rangers Tryouts, see Tryout information later in this document)
- Selection to this team will be an additional \$700 payable to CMBA via a separate registration link that will be sent to those players after the tryouts. Payment due by March 31st.
- Rangers AA Team Fee of \$800 payable by E-Transfer to <u>rangers15ufinance@gmail.com</u> Payment due April 15, 2024.
- Rangers uniform cost, there are items that are mandatory and others that are optional, cost will be determined by any extra items purchased, see example of uniform costs in appendix A attached.
 - Therefore, total cost (<u>not including Uniform</u>) is \$1820.00 or \$1860.00

15U AAA Team

- CMBA Basic Cost for Registration \$320 before Feb 1, 2024, \$360 after Feb 1, 2024 (note this registration MUST be complete prior to attending Rangers Tryouts, see Tryout information later in this document)
- Selection to this team will be an additional \$800 payable to CMBA via a separate registration link that will be sent to those players after the tryouts. Payment due by March 31st.
- Rangers AAA Team Fee of \$1000 payable by E-Transfer to <u>rangers15ufinance@gmail.com</u> Payment due April 15, 2024.
- Rangers uniform cost, there are items that are mandatory and others that are optional, cost will be determined by any extra items purchased, see example of uniform costs in appendix A attached.
 - Therefore, total cost (<u>not including Uniform</u>) is \$2120.00 or \$2160.00



18U AAA Team

- CMBA Basic Cost for Registration \$340 before Feb 1, 2024, \$370 after Feb 1, 2024 (note this registration MUST be complete prior to attending Rangers Tryouts, see Tryout information later in this document)
- Selection to this team will be an additional \$900 payable to CMBA via a separate registration link that will be sent to those players after the tryouts. Payment due by March 31st.
- Rangers AAA Team Fee of \$900 payable by E-Transfer to <u>rangers18ufinance@gmail.com</u> Payment due April 15, 2024,
- Rangers uniform cost, there are items that are mandatory and others that are optional, cost will be determined by any extra items purchased, see example of uniform costs in appendix A attached.
 - Therefore, total cost (<u>not including Uniform</u>) is \$2140.00 or \$2170.00

College Prep Team

- CMBA Basic Cost for Registration \$340 before Feb 1, 2024, \$370 after Feb 1, 2024 (note this registration MUST be complete prior to attending Rangers Tryouts, see Tryout information later in this document)
- Selection to this team will be an additional \$1100 payable to CMBA via a separate registration link that will be sent to those players after the tryouts. Payment due by March 31st.
- Rangers CP Team Fee of \$1100 payable by E-Transfer to <u>rangers18ufinance@gmail.com</u> Payment due April 15, 2024.
- Rangers uniform cost, there are items that are mandatory and others that are optional, cost will be determined by any extra items purchased, see example of uniform costs in appendix A attached.
 - Therefore, total cost (not including Uniform) is \$2540.00 or \$2570.00



<u>Uniforms</u>

Players Uniform Numbers will be determined by the Rangers program based on the following criteria. Once all teams are selected players will be requested to provide their preferred number followed by 2nd and 3rd choices.

Returning players will retain their current number unless they choose to change numbers when the process below reaches them for selection.

The process starts with the 18U players, specifically College Prep players selecting their numbers and then moves to 18U AAA. The process will then move down to 15U and 13U respectively.

Any number that was selected by Midget is not available for the Bantam players in the case that a Midget coach would like to call up a Bantam player, same goes for Peewee Players. This is why we asked players for multiple different numbers, in case there were any issues.

Based off seniority in the program and Division (18U, 15U then 13U)

The reason for this is based off coaches being able to call up players when needed and rewarding players for years committed to the program. This also allows players to keep their jerseys for more than one season (if they choose)

Rangers HP Uniform equipment is mandatory for all players in the program, first year players will be required to purchase the following items.

- White Full Button Jersey x 1
- Grey Jersey x 1
- Black drifit practice jersey x 1
- ³/₄ Sleeve practice t-shirt x 1
- PTS 30 hat x 1
- Rangers Hoodie x 1
- Rangers Cage Warm up jacket either short or long sleeve x 1
- Rangers shorts x 1

Returning players can reuse previous year's uniform items provided they are not extremely worn/damaged to help with keeping costs down where possible.

Rangers Player Mandatory Participation Programs

- Participate, as requested, with CMBA player assessments in Feb/March of each year.
- Participate, as requested, in any activities related to Challenger Baseball, typically 1 day of volunteer time.
- Participate, as requested, in any Ranger Program Fund Raising programs, this should be limited to 1 fund raiser per player at the most.
- Participate, as requested, in any workshops/clinics for practices with younger division players for organized development practices, typically 1 day of volunteer time.
